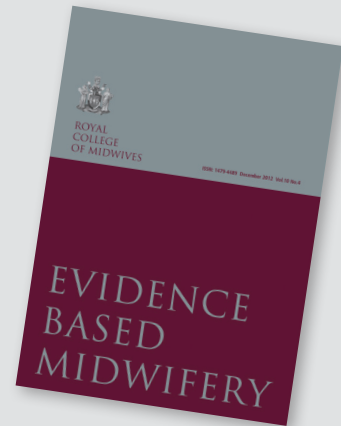


# A call for papers
